
VOLLEYBALL JUDGE'S STAND 669100




1. Unpack all parts and check against parts list to ensure that all have been included.

*Pre-assembled

- 2. Assemble Ladder frame(1) to Front frame(2) using Hex bolt M10x57mm(13), Teflon washer(8), Flat washer M10(14), and Lock nut M10(15). The Teflon washer(8) should be placed between the Front frame(2) and Ladder frame(1).
- 3. Attach Ladder cross bar-top(3) [with hole for lock pin] to the Ladder frame(1) using Hex bolt M8x50(16), Flat washer M8(17), and Lock nut M8(18). NOTE: the pin hole should be horizontal after installation
- 4. Pull up the Platform(5) and place its metal bracket over the Ladder cross bar-top(3). Align the hole in the bracket with the hole in the Ladder cross bar-top(3). Slide the Lock pin(7) all the way thru aligning the holes until it is locked.
- 5. Attach Ladder cross bar (4) [with non-slip pad] to the Ladder frame(1) using Hex bolt M8x50(16), Flat washer M8(17), and Lock nut M8(18). NOTE: non-slip pad MUST face up.
- 6. Assemble the Wheel(23) to the bottom of the Ladder frame(1) using Hex bolt M12x100(9), Washer M12(10), Hex nut M12(11), and Lock nut M12(12). Fasten the Hex nut M12(11) to make sure the Hex bolt(9) is fixed securely, and loosen the Lock nut M12(12) to allow the Wheel(23) to spin smoothly.
- 7. Check all connections, and tighten all bolts & nuts

- ALTERATION OR MODIFICATION OF EQUIPMENT MAY BE HAZARDOUS. USE ONLY AS INTENDED.
