

TOOLS REQUIRED:

- (1) 9/16" Socket Wrench and Box Wrench
- (1) 3/4" Socket Wrench and Box Wrench
- (1) 15/16" Socket Wrench and Box Wrench
- (1) Level Device

- (1) Anti-seize Compound
- (1) Scaffolding, Lull or Lift
- (1) 10 or 12 FT Step Ladder
 - (for final adjustments)

Important Note:

Installation of the Hoop Rejuvenator system requires the lifting and handling of substantial weight, up to 270 lbs. Safe installation requires at least three men and the use of appropriate material handling equipment such as scaffolding, a Lull or lift.


DO NOT ATTEMPT TO ASSEMBLE THE HOOP REJUVENATOR OFF A STEP LADDER. The Hoop Rejuvenator offers the ability to adjust the height of the board and plumb it independently. Care should be taken at each step to ensure the framework is square and plumb.

To prevent the stainless hardware from seizing, liberally apply some anti-seize compound to the bolt threads.

THIS PRODUCT USES STAINLESS STEEL HARDWARE BECAUSE OF ITS SUPERIOR RESISTANCE TO RUST AND CORROSION. STAINLESS NUTS CAN SOMETIME SEIZE ONTO THE BOLT THREADS DURING INSTALLATION OR REMOVAL. TO PREVENT THE STAINLESS HARDWARE FROM SEIZING, LIBERALLY APPLY SOME ANTI-SEIZE COMPOUND TO THE BOLT THREADS, OR SPRAY THE THREADS WITH A PENETRATING LUBRICANT, SUCH AS WD-40.


Upright Assembly:


- 1. Uninstall the existing backboard and brace that's on the gooseneck.
- 2. With the can of spray on galvanize, spray any area that is rusted. Allow galvanize to dry before continuing.
- 3. Attach the H-Frame gooseneck bracket together as shown (*figure 1*).



Frame Support Attachment:


- 1. Loosely assembly brackets together with 5/8" hardware as shown in figure 2.
- 2. Measure and set 119" to the top slot from the playing surface see figure 3.
- 3. Three band clamps are provided; use only one that fits the existing gooseneck. Stretch the band clamp on to the existing gooseneck and close it as shown in figure 4.







Board Assembly:

- **1.** Attach the appropriate brace mounting bracket to the back of the backboard as shown in figure 5.
- 2. Lift entire backboard and assembly the goal on to the board and brackets as shown in figure 6.
- **3.** Once backboard and goal is on the gooseneck, plumb the board to the playing surface. Maintain the plumb and lock it in place using the 3-1/2" OD band clamp as shown in figure 7.











Maintenance:

Thoroughly inspect the system at least twice a year check all hardware for tightness and wear.

Inspect the system for any surface rust. Brush off and protect rusted areas with a Rustoleum type zinc spray.

Check the height and plumpness of the system. Carefully adjust if needed.
