

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR 7E101 MULTI-SPORT BACKSTOP

- 1. Unpack all parts and check for damage that may have occurred during shipping. If damage has occurred, notify trucking company immediately. Lay out all parts. Remove all cardboard and packaging immediately. Wet or damp packaging may damage contents.
- 2. Read through entire instruction before beginning assembly and installation.

Note: Hardware may be packaged separately in one or more boxes. Open all packages before beginning assembly.

1/4" x 5" Hex Bolt (Part# TZ49)	(8)
1/4" Lock Nut (Part# TZ19)	(8)
5/16" Flat Washer (Part# TZ4)	(12)
5/16" Lock Nut (Part# TZ5)	(4)
27ft. Rope (Part# VZ377)	(4)



7/16" & 1/2" Ratchet with 7/16" & 1/2" Wrenches Sockets





3. Assemble uprights as shown.





CAUTION

- 4. Dig 4 holes a minimum of 49 1/4" deep and 24" across in locations shown. Prepare holes, set ground sleeves into holes, place upright into ground sleeve as shown.
- 5. Plumb and level all uprights and seal joint between ground sleeve and upright using tape (this will stop debris from entering ground sleeve during initial installation.)
- 6. Pour concrete to top of ground sleeves as shown and allow concrete to cure.




7. Unroll net in front of uprights and attach snap hooks to net.






CAUTION

8. Starting at one end, hoist net. When fully raised secure rope to rope cleat and proceed to next upright. Continue this process until entire net is fully raised. Take free end of rope after rope is secured to rope cleat and tie a loose loop around each upright below rope cleat to form a stop loop (Side View previous page). This will prevent rope from inadvertently pulling through the pulley with the upright installed.



9. Secure bottom of net with net pegs.



- 10. When removing uprights from ground sleeves be sure to install ground sleeve caps to prevent debris from entering.
- 11. After reassembly be sure to reseal the seam between upright and ground sleeve to prevent debris from entering.
