


- 2.Install ground sleeves as shown on the following page. System can be installed with either ground sleeves or anchor kit.
- 3. Rest upright on the ground with the groove facing up.
- 4. Place the winch on the upright so that the tie off is facing the top and the winch stop is seated in the gear. NOTE: The bottom of the upright has three holes through the upright for anchoring.
- 5.Slide (2) tapped flats through the groove in the upright until they line-up with the holes on the winch. Fasten the winch to the flats using a flat head cap screw provided. (Do not tighten hardware)
- 6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 for the pulley that sits above the winch. SEE DETAIL A (Do Not Tighten Hardware)
- 7. Repeat steps 4 and 5 for the (2) tie offs on the opposite standard. SEE DETAIL B (Do Not Tighten Hardware)
- 8. Hook the S-hook on the top tie off directly opposite of the pulley.
- 9. Adjust all the fittings to the proper heights then tighten all hardware.
- 10. Place a plastic end cap on top of each standard.
- 11. Anchor each standard with the fittings facing the inside of the court.
- 12. Stretch net across court and place the net cable over the pulley on the winch upright. Secure the snap hook to the end loop on the net.
- 13. Attach and tighten net straps to complete installation.
